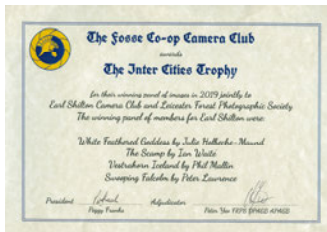
18th Aug 2018 Lutterworth President's Panel Competition – Finishing in 1st place.

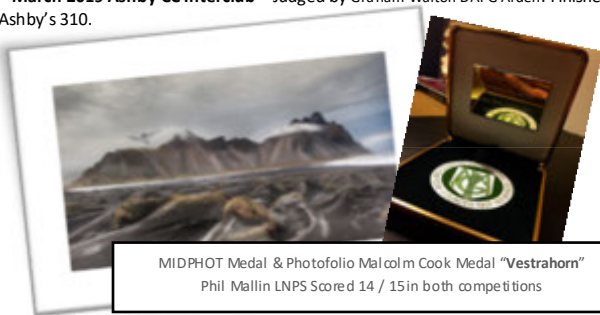

ALL ENTRIES

- Entries for club competitions must be submitted by the submission date given in the club's programme of events, unless special dispensation received from Competition Secretary.
- Entries submitted must not have been previously entered in any Earl Shilton Camera Club Photographer of the Year competition;

PRINTS

- Entries for print competitions should be mounted;
- Mount sizes must not be greater than 20x16 inches / 50x40cm;
- All submitted prints must have a completed club sticker (available on the website @ <http://www.earlshiltoncameraclub.org.uk/competition-labels/>) on the rear of the print (please put the sticker on the back bottom left of your print), giving the image Author, Title, Competition and date of submission;

PROJECTED IMAGES (PDI)

- Images may be submitted on CD, Memory Stick, Memory Card or by email to the Competition Secretary;
- The currently specified standards for projected image competitions are:
 - File type: JPEG;
 - Colour Space: sRGB;
 - Maximum Image Size: 1920 pixels wide by 1080 pixels high.
Note: Portrait format images should be no more than 1080 pixels high;
Resolution: 72dpi;
 - Filename: Should be the <image title>-<author's name>.jpg only. The Competition Secretary will add a two digit number to the front of the filename in order to simplify slideshow production;
- Where images are submitted that do not conform to these specifications, the Competition Secretary reserves the right to adjust the image accordingly. Members should note that although every endeavour will be taken to preserve image quality this may be adversely impacted by such adjustments and therefore members are strongly advised to ensure the images they submit are compliant;

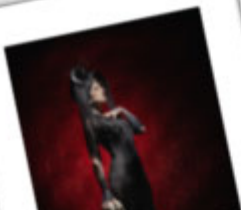

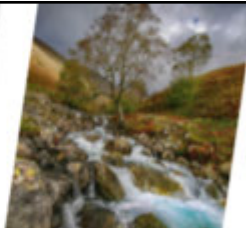

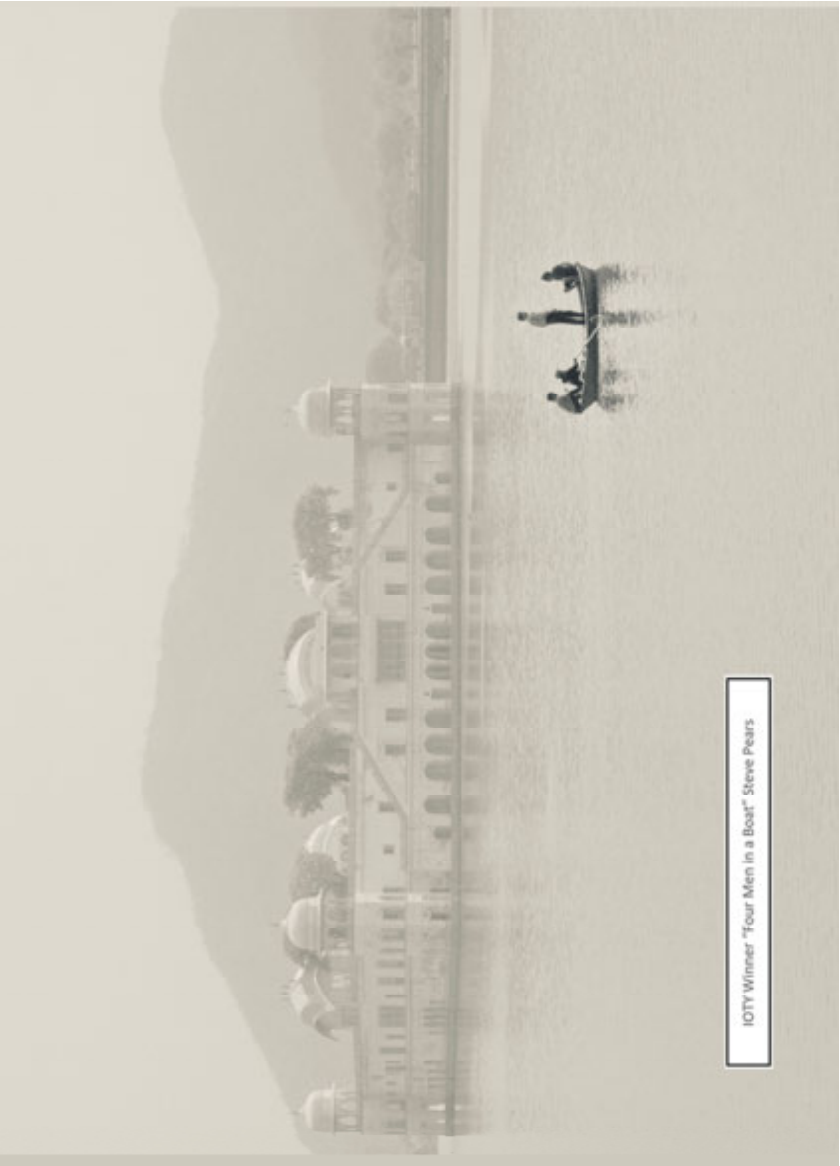
